Our Summer term homework is linked to our Mountains and Rivers topic. You can present your work by hand or use a computer- THINK CREATIVELY. Here are some suggestions for you.

<p>Create a non-fiction leaflet about mountains or rivers.</p>	<p>Research the devastation caused by the Volcano at Pompeii or elsewhere.</p>	<p>Create a model of a mountain or volcano.</p>	<p>Create two bar graphs, one showing the height of at least six different mountains and the other the lengths of six different rivers.</p>
<p>Create a pictorial representation of a mountain or river scene eg. collage, painting, pastels, photography montage etc.</p>	<p>Make a model boat from any materials you choose. Your boat must be strong enough to carry an apple and still float!</p>	<p>Write an information piece / factsheet about a river creature.</p>	<p>Write an article for a travel magazine persuading someone to visit a mountain resort.</p>
<p>Choose a poem linked to the theme of rivers or mountains, copy it neatly and illustrate. Learn it off by heart to perform in front of the class.</p>	<p>Research the heights of different mountains and the lengths of different rivers in the world. Convert them into different units of measurement e.g. metres into centimetres, kilometres etc.</p>	<p>Create 5 word problems based on a river or mountain theme. They must be 2 step problems. Remember to include the answers!</p>	<p>Write a story with a river or mountain as a setting. The story can be any genre.</p>
<p>Write a poem about rivers, mountains or coasts.</p>	<p>Create a poster about safety in or around rivers, mountains or coasts</p>	<p>Design and write a Postcard from a region with mountains or rivers e.g. Switzerland or The Nile.</p>	<p>Research a famous mountaineer.</p>
<p>Create a weather report for a mountainous region (use the internet to research the forecast)</p>	<p>Write a newspaper report about a river, mountain or coast disaster / rescue.</p>	<p>Design a 'new' mode of transport for travelling on a river. Draw a diagram and label it. (If you like you could also make a model of it)</p>	<p>Choose a mountain anywhere in the world. Research its country. How does the presence of the mountain affect the country.</p>
