Churchill Class: This week's learning

This week, children will complete the 2016 SATs papers as part of Mock tests. This will be for Maths and Reading.

GPS: We will write and annotate a paragraph about Paddington Bear. This will include the GPS we have learnt so far this year.

English: We will complete our own versions of "A Bear Called Paddington". In addition to completing an English comprehension paper.

Maths (proportion): We will help Paddington solve problems involving the relative sizes of two quantities where missing values can be found by using integer multiplication and division facts (Missed due to snow week). We will identify the value of each digit in numbers given to three decimal places and multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000 giving answers up to three decimal places. Also we will solve problems involving the calculation and conversion of units of measure, using decimal notation up to three decimal places where appropriate. We will also use, read, write and convert between standard units, converting measurements of length, mass, volume and time from a smaller unit of measure to a larger unit, and vice versa, using decimal notation to up to three decimal places. As an extension activity we will convert between miles and kilometres

Topic: We will consider who the Vikings were and why did they invade? On Thursday, we will go on our Anglo-Saxon walk.

Music: We will add musical accompaniment to the song "Happy".

PE: We will apply the rules of the game to a tournament.

RE: We will discuss, what do we mean by 'Victory'?

Computing: Designing and creating a 3D game about cyber bullying.

French: Vocabulary for objects in the classroom
