Music

This term will focus on a rock song called 'I Wanna Play In A Band.' Children will learn about singing and playing together in an ensemble. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise classic rock songs.

RE

This unit is called 'Caring for Others'. Children will learn about kindness and the importance of caring for others, by exploring the values of different religions. This includes reading stories from different faiths and learning about religious festivals and practices

Art

This Lowry unit will teach your class about 19th century painter LS Lowry. The children will have the opportunity to explore the life and work of Lowry and to learn about the industrial landscape that provided the subject of many of his paintings. Each lesson in the unit focuses on improving a key skill in art and design; comparing works of art, colour mixing, perspective, drawing figures, drawing buildings and scissor skills.

Mathematics

We will be: Using a 100 square to recognise, read and write numbers up to 100; understanding place value of 2-digit numbers and solving place value additions and subtractions. Saying the numbers 1 more and 1 less of numbers up to and just beyond 20; adding 1, 2 and 3 by counting on; subtract 1, 2, 3 or more by counting back. Finding the number bonds of 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10 and using this information to solve missing number problems and word problems involving addition and subtraction. Adding to multiples of 10 by counting on. Estimating amounts by counting on and back in 2's, 5's and 10's. Recognise, name and describe 3D shapes and sort according to properties, cubes, spheres, cones,

Science

Our unit is called 'Seasonal Changes (Autumn and Winter)' we will learn about the four seasons, with a particular focus on autumn and winter. We will learn what the word weather means and find out how different types of weather can be measured. Children will use a class weather station to observe, measure and record the weather across the seasons. They will also observe changes across the seasons by exploring the signs of autumn and winter through nature and wildlife. A range of learning activities are used in this unit including observation, discussion and learning outside. Children will also work scientifically by collecting, recording and interpreting simple data.

Topic

We will be locating and comparing the UK, The Arctic and Antarctica. We will then explore the different animals that can be found in the Polar regions and how they have adapted to survive. Alongside this we will learn about Inuits and how they live in cold regions. Children will find out about a famous polar explorer's expedition before learning about changes to the polar environments and how it can be sustained.

Computing

This term we will be using Scratch, a programming software where children will create a build programmes with different components.

This term PE will be Gymnastics using Large apparatus with Mr Digby and outdoor Multiskills with Miss Weeks.
