


## Whole School Update

Thank you to everyone, who sent in photos or designed pictures to cheer our local villagers. They were so lovely that I thought everyone should all see as many of them as possible.






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## Potter Class Update









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## Nightingale Class Update


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## Darwin Class Update


It has been a busy week at school! Darwin's bubble has grown and I have had a lot more children join. It has been nice to see some faces that I haven't seen since the lockdown began!

I have seen a few more pieces of work from several children at home. It is positive to see those who are still continuing to work hard at home– thank you!







## Shakespeare Class Update
